Past Participles



The past participle			
Regular participles			
In order to form the past participle, you need to follow these steps:	-ar	-er	-ir
1) Take the verb in the infinitive	1) <i>bailar</i>	1) <i>comer</i>	1) <i>vivir</i>
2) Remove its ending	2) <i>bail-</i>	2) <i>com-</i>	2) <i>viv-</i>
3) Add <b>-ado</b> for the <b>-ar</b> verbs and <b>-ido</b> for the <b>-er/-ir</b> verbs	3) <b><i>bailado</i></b> danced	3) <b><i>comido</i></b> eaten	3) <b><i>vivido</i></b> lived

**IMPORTANT:** When the stem of the verb ends in -a, -e, or -o, a written mark (accent) is written on the "i" of "-ido." For example: *traer* (to bring) - *traído*

Participles with two forms			
Participle used as:			
Verb	Verb	Adjective	English
<i>imprimir</i> to print	<b><i>imprimido</i></b>	<b><i>impreso</i></b>	printed
<i>freir</i> to fry	<b><i>freído</i></b>	<b><i>frito</i></b>	fried
<i>bendecir</i> to bless	<b><i>bendecido</i></b>	<b><i>bendito</i></b>	blessed
<i>elegir</i> to elect	<b><i>elegido</i></b>	<b><i>electo</i></b>	elected

**IMPORTANT:** There are participles with two forms. The first ending in *-ado*, *-ido* refers to an action or verb and is used in compound tenses. The second ending in *-so*, *-to* is used as an adjective.
