Passé Simple

## Irregular Verbs in *Passé Simple*



Infinitive	Stem	Verb conjugated with <i>je</i> and <i>il</i>	English
Stem with the vowel <i>u</i>			
<i>être</i>	<i>fu-</i>	<i>je fus - il fut</i>	to be
<i>avoir</i>	<i>eu-</i>	<i>j'eus - il eut</i>	to have
<i>pouvoir</i>	<i>pu-</i>	<i>je pus - il put</i>	to be able to
<i>devoir</i>	<i>du-</i>	<i>je dus - il dut</i>	to have to
<i>croire</i>	<i>cru-</i>	<i>je crus - il crut</i>	to believe
<i>savoir</i>	<i>su-</i>	<i>je sus - il sut</i>	to know
<i>vouloir</i>	<i>voulu-</i>	<i>je voulus - il voulut</i>	to want
<i>vivre</i>	<i>vécu-</i>	<i>je vécus - il vécut</i>	to live
<i>mourir</i>	<i>mouru-</i>	<i>je mourus - il mourut</i>	to die
Stem with the vowel <i>i</i>			
<i>faire</i>	<i>fi-</i>	<i>je fis - il fit</i>	to do
<i>prendre</i>	<i>pri-</i>	<i>je pris - il prit</i>	to take
<i>mettre</i>	<i>mi-</i>	<i>je mis - il mit</i>	to put
<i>dire</i>	<i>di-</i>	<i>je dis - il dit</i>	to say
<i>voir</i>	<i>vi-</i>	<i>je vis - il vit</i>	to see
Stem with <i>in-</i>			
<i>venir</i>	<i>vin-</i>	<i>je vins - il vint</i>	to come
<i>tenir</i>	<i>tin-</i>	<i>je tins - il tint</i>	to hold

Did you notice that sometimes the stem for the *passé simple* comes from the past participle? For example, *croire* → *j'ai cru* and *cru* happens to be the stem for the *passé simple*.

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
