Use	Spanish	English	Considerations
prices	<i>Estas naranjas cuestan ochocientos pesos.</i>	These oranges cost eight hundred pesos.	
dates, years	<i>Hoy es veintiséis de septiembre de dos mil veintiuno.</i>	Today is September twenty-sixth, two thousand and twenty-one.	
the hour	<i>Son las tres de la tarde.</i>	It's three in the afternoon.	Hours are preceded by the definite feminine article: <i>la</i> (the) for one o'clock and <i>las</i> (the) for all hours after one.
age	<i>Emma tiene veintisiete años.</i>	Emma is twenty-seven years old.	
statistics	<i>El noventa y cinco por ciento de los estudiantes aprobó la clase.</i>	Ninety-five percent of students passed the class.	Percentages are typically preceded by a masculine singular article: either <i>el</i> (the) or <i>un</i> (a).
quantity	<i>Mil estudiantes tomaron la prueba.</i>	One thousand students took the test.	
measurement	<i>Necesito una mesa de noventa centímetros de largo.</i>	I need a table that is ninety centimeters long.	
weight	<i>Esta maleta pesa ocho kilos.</i>	This suitcase weights eight kilos.	
distance	<i>El pueblo está a dos kilómetros de aquí.</i>	The town is two kilometers from here.
