Tenses and their corresponding tense in indirect speech

Related to the past				
Direct speech	Indirect speech			
Present Ella dijo: " Tengo hambre." She said, "I'm hungry."	Imperfect Ella dijo que tenía hambre. She said she was hungry.			
Present continuous Ella dijo: "Estoy trabajando." She said, "I'm working."	Imperfect continuous Ella dijo que estaba trabajando. She said that she was working.			
Present perfect Ella dijo: "Ya he comido." She said, "I have eaten already."	Past perfect (pluperfect) Ella dijo que ya había comido . She said that she had already eaten.			
Preterite Ella dijo: "Tuve hambre." She said, "I was hungry."	Past perfect (pluperfect) Ella dijo que había tenido hambre. She said she had been hungry.			
Future Ella dijo: " Tendré hambre." She said, "I will be hungry."	Present conditional Ella dijo que tendría hambre. She said that she would be hungry.			
Future perfect Ella dijo: "Ya habré comido." She said, "I will have eaten already."	Past conditional Ella dijo que ya habría comido . She said that she will have already eaten.			
Imperative Ella dijo: "Dame comida." She said, "Give me food."	Imperfect subjunctive Ella pidió que le dieras comida. She asked you to give her food.			
Present subjunctive Ella dijo: "Quiero que me den comida." She said, "I want them to give me food."	Imperfect subjunctive Ella dijo que quería que le dieran comida. She said that she wanted them to give her food.			
Present perfect subjunctive Ella dijo: "No creo que me hayan dado comida." She said, "I don't think that they have given me food."	Past perfect subjunctive Ella dijo que no creía que le hubiesen/hubieran dado comida. She said that she didn't think that they had given her food.			

IMPORTANT

Some verb tenses don't change in reported speech. These include the **imperfect** – both indicative and subjunctive, — **the past perfect** – indicative and subjunctive,— and the **conditional** – present and past. Los niños dijeron: "**Queríamos** ir al parque." The kids said, "We wanted to go to the park."

Los niños dijeron que **querían** ir al parque. The kids said that they wanted to go to the park.

Direct speech	Indirect speech			
Present Ella dice: " Tengo hambre." She says, "I'm hungry."	Present Ella dice que tiene hambre. She says that she is hungry.			
Present continuous Ella dice: "Estoy trabajando." She says, "I'm working."	Present continuous Ella dice que está trabajando. She says that she is working.			
Present perfect Ella dice: "Ya he comido." She says, "I have already eaten."	Present perfect Ella dice que ya ha comido . She says that she has already eaten.			
Preterite Ella dice: "Tuve hambre." She says, "I was hungry."	Preterite Ella dice que tuvo hambre. She says that she was hungry.			
Future Ella dice: " Tendré hambre." She says, "I will be hungry."	Future Ella dice que tendrá hambre. She says that she will be hungry.			
Future perfect Ella dice: "Ya habré comido ." She says, "I will have eaten."	Future perfect Ella dice que ya habrá comido . She says that she will have already eaten.			
Imperative Ella dice: " Da me más comida." She says, "Give me more food."	Present subjunctive Ella pide que le des más comida. She asks that you give her more food.			
Present subjunctive Ella dice: "Quiero que me den comida." She says, "I want them to give me food."	Present subjunctive Ella dice que quiere que le den comida. She says that she wants them to give her food.			



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Additional time expressions and their change in reported speech

			Example
ayer yesterday	→	el día anterior the previous day	Estefanía dijo: "Necesitaba la orden para ayer ." Estefanía said, "I needed the order for yesterday." Estefanía dijo que necesitaba la orden para el día anterior . Estefanía said she needed the order for the previous day.
la semana/el mes/el año que viene the upcoming week/month/year	→	a la semana/al mes/ al año siguiente in the upcoming week/ month/year	Los estudiantes preguntaron: "¿Tendremos examen la semana que viene?" The students asked, "Will we have a test next week?" Los estudiantes preguntaron si tendrían examen la semana siguiente. The students asked if they would have an exam the following week.
la semana/el mes/el año pasado the last week/month/year	→	la semana/el mes/el año anterior in the previous week/ month/year	Mi mamá dijo: "Pagué todas las cuentas el mes pasado ." My mom said, "I paid all the bills last month." Mi mamá dijo que había pagado todas las cuentas el mes anterior . My mom said that she had paid all the bills the previous month.
hace + period of time period of time + ago	→	hacía + period of time / period of time + antes for + period of time	El estudiante dijo: "Hace tres años que toco piano." The student said, "I have played piano for three years." El estudiante dijo que hacía tres años que tocaba piano. The student said that he had been playing piano for three years.

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
