French Prepositions



**Verbs which don't need a preposition in French but do in English**

The context is very important to choose the right equivalent in French.

Verbs derived from "to look" <i>regarder</i>	
<i>chercher</i>	to look for
<i>surveiller</i>	to look after
<i>regarder</i>	to look at
<i>détourner les yeux</i>	to look away
<i>baisser les yeux</i>	to look down
<i>lever les yeux</i>	to look up
<i>chercher, se renseigner</i>	to look into
<i>observer</i>	to look on
<i>ignorer</i>	to look past

Verbs derived from "to bring" <i>apporter</i>	
<i>élever</i>	to bring up
<i>apporter, emmener</i>	to bring along
<i>rapporter</i>	to bring back
<i>avancer</i>	to bring forward

Verbs derived from "to turn" <i>tourner</i>	
<i>allumer</i>	to turn on
<i>éteindre</i>	to turn off
<i>baisser, refuser</i>	to turn down
<i>devenir</i>	to turn to, into
<i>se retourner</i>	to turn around
<i>faire demi-tour</i>	to turn back

Verbs derived from "to grow" <i>grandir / cultiver</i>	
<i>grandir</i>	to grow up
<i>s'éloigner</i>	to grow apart
<i>pousser</i>	to grow out
<i>repousser</i>	to grow back
<i>devenir</i>	to grow into

Verbs derived from "to take" <i>prendre</i>	
<i>enlever</i>	to take off
<i>assimiler</i>	to take in
<i>retirer, sortir avec</i>	to take out
<i>enlever, confisquer</i>	to take away

Verbs derived from "to go" <i>aller</i>	
<i>descendre</i>	to go down
<i>traverser</i>	to go through
<i>sortir</i>	to go out
<i>suivre</i>	to go after
<i>continuer</i>	to go on
<i>choisir</i>	to go for

Verbs derived from "to throw" <i>lancer</i>	
<i>jeter</i>	to throw out
<i>vomir</i>	to throw up
<i>se débarrasser de</i>	to throw aside
<i>rajouter</i>	to throw in
<i>induire en erreur, déstabiliser</i>	to throw off
