## Conjunctions



Conjunctions with Subjunctive		
<i>A menos que</i>	unless	<i>No voy a ir a la excursión a menos que deje de llover.</i> I am not going to the trip unless it stops raining.
<i>Antes de que</i>	before	<i>Tienen que marcar un gol antes de que se acabe el tiempo.</i> They have to score before the time ends.
<i>Con tal de que</i>	provided that	<i>Te dejo ir al viaje con tal de que me traigas un souvenir.</i> I'll let you go to the trip, provided that you bring me a souvenir.
<i>En caso de que</i>	in the event that, if	<i>En caso de que te encuentres mal, ven al hospital.</i> In the event you start feeling bad, go to the hospital
<i>Para que</i>	so that	<i>Llámame para que te cuente el plan.</i> Call me so that I can tell you the plan.
<i>Sin que</i>	without	<i>No me voy sin que me devuelvan mi dinero.</i> I'm not going anywhere without my money.
<i>Siempre y cuando</i>	as long as	<i>Te lo cuento siempre y cuando me prometas que no se lo vas a decir a nadie.</i> I'll tell you as long as you don't tell anyone.
<i>A condición que</i> <i>Con la condición de que</i>	under the condition	<i>Te presto mi carro con la condición de que me lo devuelvas mañana.</i> You can borrow my car under the condition you return it to me tomorrow.
<i>A fin de que</i>	in order that	<i>Estudia mucho a fin de que pases el examen.</i> Study a lot so that you pass the exam.
<i>A no ser que</i>	unless	<i>Estaré de vacaciones a no ser que me llame mi jefe.</i> I will be on vacation unless my boss calls me.

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## Conjunctions

Conjunctions with Subjunctive and Indicative		
<i>Quando</i>	when	<i>Quando tenga dinero viajaré por todo el mundo.</i> When I have money, I'll travel around the world.
<i>Después de que</i>	after	<i>Después de que termine el examen, iremos a la fiesta.</i> After I finish my exam, we'll go to the party.
<i>En cuanto</i>	when/ as soon as	<i>En cuanto reciba la confirmación, te aviso.</i> I'll let you know as soon as I get the confirmation.
<i>Hasta que</i>	until	<i>No puedo decirte nada hasta que no se haga público.</i> I can't tell you anything until it's made public.
<i>Tan pronto como</i>	as soon as	<i>Tan pronto como llegue a casa, iré a la cama</i> As soon as I arrive home, I'll go to sleep.
<i>A pesar de que</i>	in spite of	<i>A pesar de que haga mal tiempo, iremos de excursión.</i> In spite of the bad weather, we will go on a hike.
<i>Mientras que</i>	as long as	<i>Mientras que no llegue tarde, puede venir.</i> As long as he doesn't arrive late, he can come.
<i>Apenas</i>	as soon as	<i>Apenas tenga dinero, me iré de viaje.</i> As soon as I have money, I'll go on a trip.
<i>Aún cuando</i>	even when	<i>Aún cuando no tenga clase, iré a la universidad.</i> Even when I don't have class, I'll go to the university.
<i>Aunque*</i>	even though	<i>Aunque tenga muchas vacaciones, no suelo ir de viaje.</i> Even though I have a lot of holidays, I don't travel that much.
<i>Siempre que</i>	provided that	<i>Haré la comida siempre que tú limpies los platos.</i> I'll cook, provided that you wash the dishes.

\*When *aunque* means "although" it is used with the indicative:  
*Llegamos aunque nos perdimos.* We arrived although we got lost.

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
