<i>bomba</i>	bomb	<i>bombilla</i>	light bulb
<i>cama</i>	bed	<i>camilla</i>	stretcher
<i>caballo</i>	horse	<i>caballete</i>	easel
<i>carreta</i>	cart	<i>carretilla</i>	wheelbarrow
<i>cuaderno</i>	notebook	<i>cuadernillo</i>	booklet
<i>cuchara</i>	spoon	<i>cucharita</i>	teaspoon
<i>guerra</i>	war	<i>guerrilla</i>	warfare
<i>hoyo</i>	hole	<i>hoyuelo</i>	dimple
<i>manteca</i>	lard	<i>mantequilla</i>	butter
<i>palo</i>	stick	<i>palillo</i>	toothpick
<i>parra</i>	vine	<i>parrilla</i>	grill
<i>pan</i>	bread	<i>panecillo</i>	roll
<i>plato</i>	plate	<i>platillo</i>	dish
<i>reja</i>	grid	<i>rejilla</i>	rack
<i>vara</i>	rod	<i>varilla</i>	dipstick
<i>ventana</i>	window	<i>ventanilla</i>	counter/pane

Note: In order to make the actual diminutive of the base form, it would be necessary to use the rules presented in the post. For example, *bocado* > *bocadito*, *barco* > *barquito*.

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
