Verbs that take the auxiliary être (to be)

The acronym **Dr & Mrs Vandertramp** can help you memorize them.

D	devenir	to become
R	revenir	to come back

М	monter*	to climb
R	rester	to stay
S	sortir*	to leave

V	venir**	to come
Α	aller	to go
N	naître	to be born
D	descendre*	to go down
E	entrer*	to enter
R	rentrer	to return, to go back in
Т	tomber	to fall
R	retourner*	to go back
Α	arriver	to arrive
М	mourir	to die
Р	partir	to leave

^{*} These verbs use the auxiliary *avoir* if they are followed by a direct object.
