Other Expressions of Place



There are some other ways to express place. Check out these useful and frequent expressions:

Italian	English	Examples
With the preposition a + definite article(s)		
<i>accanto a</i>	next to	<i>La farmacia accanto al cinema.</i> The pharmacy is next to the theater.
<i>davanti a</i>	in front of	<i>Sono tutto il giorno davanti al computer.</i> I am in front of a computer all day.
<i>a destra/sinistra</i>	to the right/left	<i>Il bagno è a destra.</i> The bathroom is on the right.
<i>dietro a</i>	behind	<i>Il cane è dietro alla porta.</i> The dog is behind the door.
<i>dentro (a)*</i>	inside, within	<i>Le chiavi sono dentro la borsa.</i> The keys are inside the purse.
<i>intorno a</i>	around	<i>Non c'è nessuno intorno a me.</i> There is nobody around me.
<i>in cima a</i>	on top of	<i>Vedi la neve in cima al monte?</i> Do you see the snow on top of the mountain?
<i>sopra (a)*</i>	over	<i>La coperta è sopra al letto.</i> The blanket is on the bed.
<i>sotto (a)*</i>	under	<i>Il gatto è sotto al tavolo.</i> The cat is under the table.
<i>vicino a</i>	close to	<i>Il museo è vicino alla piazza.</i> The museum is close to the square.
* The preposition a is optional.

Italian	English	Examples
With the preposition da+definite article(s)		
<i>fuori da</i>	outside	<i>Il cinema è fuori dal centro città.</i> The theater is outside the city center.
<i>lontano da</i>	far from	<i>Il ristorante non è lontano da casa.</i> The restaurant is not far from home.
With the preposition di+definite article(s)		
<i>prima di**</i>	before	<i>La pizzeria è prima della piazza.</i> The pizzeria is before the square.
<i>dopo</i>	after	<i>Abito dopo il ponte.</i> I live after the bridge.
<i>fuori di</i>	out of	<i>Ho dimenticato le chiavi e sono rimasto fuori di casa!</i> I forgot my keys and I was left out of the house!
