Expressions	Translation	Example	Translation	Use
vaya teatrito	what a show	Vaya teatrito el que hicieron los vecinos anoche.	What a show the neighbors made last night!	As a pejorative form
qué carita	what a face	Qué carita tienen después de trabajar toda la noche.	What a face you have after you worked all night!	As a form of sarcasm
dame un momentito	give me a moment/second	Dame un momentito para responder tu mensaje.	Give me a second to reply to your message.	As a polite form/smaller size
está rubita	she is a blondie	La bebé de Elisa está rubita.	Elisa's baby is a blondie.	As a form of endearment
poquito a poquito	little by little	Poquito a poquito te recuperarás	Little by little you will feel better.	As a form of endearment
qué tardecita	what an afternoon	Qué tardecita. No tuve tiempo de descansar.	What an afternoon. I didn't have time to rest.	As a form of sarcasm
cuidadito con...	beware	Cuidadito con llegar tarde a la clase.	Beware of arriving late to class.	As a polite form
no (saber) nadita	not to know anything	No sé nadita de lo que me estás preguntando.	I don't know (absolutely) anything of what you're asking me.	To give a more precise meaning
todo	everything	Sé todo sobre comprar en línea.	I know (absolutely) everything about online shopping.	To give a more precise meaning
decir una mentirilla / mentirijilla	to tell a little lie	Dije una mentirilla para no tener problemas.	I told a little lie to avoid problems.	To downgrade importance
apenitas	barely/recently or just	Apenitas logré terminar la tarea. / Apenitas llegué.	I barely finished the homework / I have just arrived.	To give a more precise meaning
ya merito	almost	Ya merito termina mi turno.	I'm almost done with my shift.	To give a more precise meaning
un sueñito	a nap	Me voy a echar un sueñito.	I'm going to take a nap.	As a form of endearment/ smaller size
clarito	clearly	Te escucho clarito.	I hear you clearly.	To highlight a characteristic
quedito	quietly	Dilo quedito.	Say it quietly.	As a polite form
