Past Tenses in the Subjunctive



Imperfect Subjunctive 1: -ra form		
	Endings	Example
yo	-ra	comiera
tú	-ras	comieras
él/ella/Ud.	-ra	comiera
nosotros	-ramos	comiéramos
*vosotros	-rais	comierais
ellos/ellas/Uds.	-ran	comieran

Imperfect Subjunctive 2: -se form		
	Endings	Example
yo	-se	comiese
tú	-ses	comieses
él/ella/Ud.	-se	comiese
nosotros	-semos	comiésemos
*vosotros	-seis	comieseis
ellos/ellas/Uds.	-sen	comiesen

*vosotros is only used in Spain

IMPORTANT: endings are the same for *-ar*, *-er*, and *ir* verbs
The form of *nosotros* has a written accent in the last syllable of the stem to indicate most prominent vowel in the word.



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Irregular stems in the imperfect subjunctive

IMPORTANT: all verbs that have irregular preterites also show irregularities in the imperfect subjunctive

	haber	+ Past Participle
yo	hubiera	
tú	hubieras	
él/ella/Ud.	hubiera	
nosotros	hubiéramos	
*vosotros	hubierais	
ellos/ellas/Uds.	hubieran	

Past Perfect Subjunctive 2: -se form		
	haber	+ Past Participle
yo	hubiese	
tú	hubieses	
él/ella/Ud.	hubiese	
nosotros	hubiésemos	
*vosotros	hubieseis	
ellos/ellas/Uds.	hubiesen

Present Perfect Subjunctive	
	<i>haber</i>
yo	<i>haya</i>
tú	<i>hayas</i>
él/ella/Ud.	<i>haya</i>
nosotros	<i>hayamos</i>
*vosotros	<i>hayais</i>
ellos/ellas/Uds.	<i>hayan</i>
