The imperfect tense conjugations



These are examples of verbs conjugated in the imperfect.

Regular verbs			
	-AR (estudiar)	-ER (comer)	-IR (vivir)
yo	estudi aba	com ía	viv ía
tú	estudi abas	com ías	viv ías
él, ella, usted	estudi aba	com ía	viv ía
nosotros, nosotras	estudi ábamos	com íamos	viv íamos
*vosotros, vosotras	estudi abais	com íais	viv íais
ellos, ellas, ustedes	estudi aban	com ían	viv ían

- * *vosotros/vosotras* is only used in Spain
- To make the imperfect tense in Spanish, take out the verb ending (-AR, -ER, -IR) and add the corresponding ending based on the subject.
- Note that verbs ending in -ER and -IR have the same endings in the imperfect, and they always have an accent mark.
- For -AR verbs, only the conjugation for nosotros/nosotras has an accent mark.

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These are examples of verbs conjugated in the imperfect.

Reflexive verbs			
	-AR (levantarse)	-ER (perderse)	-IR (vestirse)
yo	me levant aba	me perd ía	me vest ía
tú	te levant abas	te perd ías	te vest ías
él, ella, usted	se levant aba	se perd ía	se vest ía
nosotros, nosotras	nos levant ábamos	nos perd íamos	nos vest íamos
*vosotros, vosotras	os levant abais	os perd íais	os vest íais
ellos, ellas, ustedes	se levant aban	se perd ían	se vest ían

- * *vosotros/vosotras* is only used in Spain
- Reflexive verbs follow the same patterns as regular verbs. Just don't forget to add the reflexive pronoun (me, te, se, nos, os, se) before the verb.

These are examples of verbs conjugated in the imperfect.

Irregular verbs			
	SER	IR	VER
yo	era	iba	veía
tú	eras	ibas	veías
él, ella, usted	era	iba	veía
nosotros, nosotras	éramos	íbamos	veíamos
*vosotros, vosotras	erais	ibais	veíais
ellos, ellas, ustedes	eran	iban	veían

* *vosotros/vosotras* is only used in Spain

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
