## Interrogative and exclamative homonyms

Interrogative or exclamative words		Non-interrogative or exclamative words	
<b>qué</b> what, which	<i>¿Qué quieres?</i> What do you want?	<b>que</b> (relative pronoun) that, who, which	<i>La casa <b>que</b> compré es muy grande.</i> The house that I bought is very big.
		(conjunction) that	<i>Carlos me dijo <b>que</b> iba a la tienda.</i> Carlos said that he was going to the store.
<b>cómo</b> how	<i>¿Cómo te sientes?</i> How do you feel?	<b>como</b> (relative adverb) as, like	<i>Habla <b>como</b> si supiera del tema.</i> He speaks as if he knew about the topic.
		(conjunction) since, because	<b>Como</b> tenía sueño, se fue a dormir. Since he was sleepy, he went to bed.
<b>cuánto/a</b> <b>cuántos/as</b> how much/how many	<i>¡Cuánta comida!</i> So much food!	(1st person present of <i>comer</i> [to eat]) I eat	<b>Como</b> mucha proteína todos los días. I eat lots of protein every day.
		<b>cuanto</b> (relative adverb) as much/as many	<i>Carlos estudió <b>cuanto</b> pudo para aprobar el examen.</i> Carlos studied as much as he could to pass the exam.
<b>dónde</b> where	<i>No sabemos dónde es la reunión.</i> We don't know where the meeting is.	<b>donde</b> (relative adverb) where	<i>Esta es la casa <b>donde</b> crecí.</i> This is the house where I grew up.
<b>cuándo</b> when	<i>¿Cuándo vamos a la tienda?</i> When are we going to the store?	<b>cuando</b> (relative adverb) when	<i>Lo acabaré <b>cuando</b> tenga tiempo.</i> I'll finish it when I have time.
<b>quién</b> who	<i>¿Quién es la chica de amarillo?</i> Who is the girl in yellow?	<b>quien</b> (relative pronoun) who	<i>La chica con <b>quien</b> trabajé no vino.</i> The girl with whom I worked didn't come.

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
